In the Budget Speech for 2016-17, the High Tech School Programme was announced by which all classes from 8 to 12 will be made High Tech. As per Government Order read as 1st above, Government decided to implement the High Tech School Project on a pilot basis in schools in 4 selected constituencies in the State and have identified IT@School Project as the implementing agency for this programme.
